## EXAMS

What should we anticipate for the overall process to book an exam?

You can start reading the [“How to sign up for exams” manual](#) whenever you have some time, but the process will be available 15 days before the exam itself.

Will our professors coordinate individual exams or is there a "proctor" who administers exams? What are we going to do at the final examinations, and what do professors expect from us at the exam? Will the session responding to these exam review questions be available via Zoom? When might that occur?

## FINAL DISSERTATION

Could we have some guidelines for the thesis? When should we choose our subject; to which professor can we ask? Will there be propositions of subjects or should we find them by ourselves? What's the structure of the thesis: pages, format, citation style? Is there a guidebook online or available someplace on Moodle?

The guide includes research workflows, bibliographic methods, and useful practices to track sources and citations. Also best practices to develop a research agenda ahead of the dissertation.

As you will find, research skills will be the focus of the second year activities.
