WHAT DOES A TUTOR JUNIOR DO?

1. Can **provide useful information** about the university services and offices, the master's degree, exams and activities;
2. Can give orientation about the **University's sections** (School, Department);
3. Can be a reassuring person if you need help in solving some criticisms.





Why would you need a student to help other students?

It is about **peer tutoring**.

You can get the information and help you need from someone who is in the **same social group** as you, as they have **past experience** and **knowledge** that they can **share**. There is no hierarchy.





WHAT A TUTOR JUNIOR IS NOT

The tutor junior is **not** the:

- Back office Scuola di Scienze Umane
- Local Development teaching office
- Other university offices

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HOW TO BECOME A TUTOR JUNIOR

1. Apply to the call

The call for student-tutors "BeTutor!" is opens in April/May in UNIWEB.

2. Participate to the interview

University merit, skills and aptitudes, are assessed during a selection interview.

3. Participate in the trainings

Winners are eligible for a systematic training regime, both at the beginning and during their learning activity, thanks to periodic monitoring and assessment meetings.

You can **check the call on Uniweb** in April, as it includes all the specific information on the selection process and the work our tutors carry out (including remuneration).

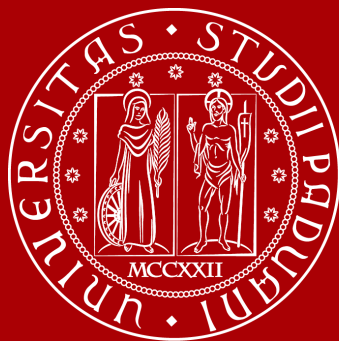
