

Registering for graduation

In order to graduate you must **register for graduation on Uniweb** by the deadline set for each graduation period.

The registration procedure is broken down into several steps and requires your supervisor to approve your dissertation title. In order to graduate, you must also have sat and recorded all the examinations of your study plan at least 15 days before the graduation dates. You must also have paid the tuition fees and have submitted your dissertation in accordance with the procedure and by the set deadlines. If you do not pay the revenue stamp for graduation, your student's records cannot be approved.

When to register for graduation

Academic Year 2023-2024

- > To graduate in the **First period, from 5 February 2024 to 30 April 2024** (insert application from 6 November 2023 to 11 January 2024).
- > To graduate in the **Second period, from 3 June 2024 to 20 July 2024** (insert application from 26 February 2024 to 7 May 2024).
- > To graduate from **Third Period A, from 2 September 2024 to 26 October 2024** (insert application from 3 June 2024 to 16 July 2024).

- Professors have tools to detect plagiarism and AI-generated texts



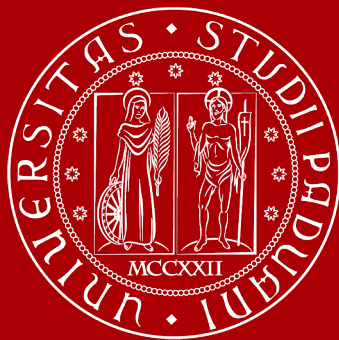
- Explore carefully the research expertise and thesis topics of your professor (unipd website, their articles, etc.)

- *Remember: any Unipd professor can be a supervisor*
