

DRAMATURG. A German word best translated into English as Literary Editor (as Kenneth Tynan, first Literary Editor of the National Theatre). The *dramaturg* has to advise about suitable plays, read new ones, sometimes work with authors on alterations, write programme notes and be prepared to act as an extra Public Relations man.
