- **English**-medium courses



MANDATORY

- ✓ **BA (or higher) in English/Anglo-American Language and Literature**
- ✓ **Proven skills in English** compatible with:
C1 level (CEFR) or equivalent
(**no** certification required, *yet* see last item)
- ✓ **At least:**
 - **12 credits in English Language**
 - **12 credits in English/Anglo-American Literature**
 - **6 credits in General/Applied Linguistics, Language Teaching, Germanic Philology, etc.**





NOT Mandatory

BONUSES

- **GPA/Average grade: at least 60%**
of Maximum GPA/Average grade possible
(all results will be normalized to 100)
- **C1 certificate**





PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

1st Year

Advanced study on:

- English Language, Linguistics and Translation (2 exams)
- English/Anglo-American Literature (2 exams)
- and Philology

2nd Year

Professional specialisation in *either*
English Language, Linguistics and Translation
or English/Anglo-American Literature
(further courses + thesis)

The programme includes Innovative courses in English (ie. Teaching of the English Language, History of the English Language, Literary Translation, Critical and Teaching Approaches to English Literature, etc.)

FURTHER HELP

- Even distribution of courses across the two semesters

The total amount of credits is 120 (54 + 66). There is **no** internal barrage between first and second year.

You will be able to be admitted to the second year even if you have **not** completed the first year's 54 credits.

All courses are taught on a **one-off basis**. They are **not** repeated in the second semester.

“Biennalisation” means attending two different English Language/Literature courses in two different academic years.

The second-year English Literature course may cover the same period as the first-year one or a different one, depending on your intended specialization and final thesis.

Contact your English Literature teacher for further advice.

While not compulsory as per the Italian law, **attendance** is warmly encouraged, especially for those courses that require simultaneous work during the classes.

We do aim to avoid **overlapping** at all costs. In the event of inevitable clashes, do refer to your teachers.
