- ✦ Autumn Semester: 1st May
- ✦ Spring Semester: 15th October

Application deadlines:

- ✦ Autumn Semester: 31st May
- ✦ Spring Semester: 15th November

Autumn semester:

- ✦ **Study period:** Mid-September – Mid-December
- ✦ **Exam period:** Mid-December – End of January

Spring semester:

- ✦ **Study period:** Beginning of February – Mid-May
- ✦ **Exam period:** Mid-May – End of June

Visa, residence permit and insurance:

EU and EEA citizens

In case your stay in Hungary does not exceed 3 months, you do not need a study visa. Your passport and/or national identity card are sufficient documentation for your entry and residence in Hungary for study purposes. If you are planning to stay longer, you need to apply for a registration card, which you are entitled to be granted with the submission of the following documents:

- ✦ proof of payment of tuition fees
- ✦ approval document of the host university

Make sure that you have health insurance which covers your stay in Hungary. If you haven't yet received it, ask your health insurance agency of your home country to issue a European Health Insurance Card.

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Non-EU citizens

As a non-EU citizen you are required to apply for a residence permit for a purpose of studies if you wish to study in Hungary. On the application form you will be asked to give details of the host institution.

In the application you have to enclose:

- + documentation detailing your prospective accommodation
- + proof of financial means of subsistence
- + school certificate
- + existence of comprehensive health insurance

Health issues:

If you have any problems during the semester please check your insurance company first.

- + If you have insurance you can only visit a doctor for free if your company is in contract with the doctor.
- + If you have no insurance, but you have European Health Insurance Card, you can visit any doctor, but you have to pay for the service. The European Health Insurance Card ensures free-visits only if it is an emergency case (e.g.: accident, injury, severe pain, etc.).
- + If you have no insurance, neither European Health Insurance Card, you are free to visit any doctors, but you will have to pay for any kind of service.

Accommodation

Foreign students might find accommodation either in private flats or in dormitories. **Please note, you should arrange your accommodation yourself by the time you arrive at PPCU.**

There are two possible ways to arrange accommodation:

Mentor system
