Please note the following information: as the Nursing degree is taught in two different campus, located in two different islands (São Miguel and Terceira), students may be placed also in Terceira island. Courses in Clinical Teaching have limited places.</p>
Language Requirements  Portuguese Foreign Language	<p>Classes are taught in Portuguese. There may be some tutorial support in English. Therefore, B1 level of Portuguese is recommended. Students must do the Portuguese language course in the Erasmus+ OLS platform.</p> <p>Portuguese Languages classes, in the UAc, the courses are recommended and start on the first day of classes in the first semester (September) or in February for the second semester. The Portuguese course in Angra do Heroísmo campus requires a minimum of 10 students enrolled. The PLE course has an administrative fee, nonrefundable, of 25,00€, paid before the arrival. Students will receive the payment instructions, by email.</p> <p>Level and code of Portuguese course: Portuguese Language Course I (code 0600001) – level A1/A2 Portuguese Language Course II (code 0400254) – level B1</p>
