## Student Exchange

### Nomination & Application Procedures

#### Nomination Procedure

The home university shall nominate their students through an online form (link sent in email to partner universities) no later than 1 April for Autumn and 1 October for Spring.

#### Application Deadlines

For Autumn Semester: 15 April  
For Spring Semester: 15 October

#### Application Instructions

A complete application includes the following:

- The MoveON application form
- Copy of identity documentation
- Transcript of academic records
- Selection of Courses form/Course plan


## Arrival Day & Orientation
