Yes, but 50% of the courses should be taken from the Teacher Training and Education Faculty. Students will apply for other Faculties' courses once they arrive at UAM through an online form.

Students need to reserve their spot by sending the signed learning agreement by email when it is required by the International Relations Office, before the enrolment date for each academic semester. Please, notice that each course has a limited number of places reserved for incoming students. Only students with a full year mobility can apply for annual courses.
