Main Topics

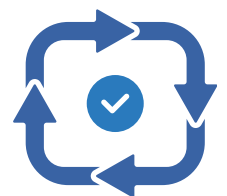
- HCEinP publishes research and reflections on education, health, and well-being, including (but not limited to):
